

TWDB Update:

- On June 4th, the Texas Water Development Board approved \$1,195,098 in grants through the Agricultural Water Conservation Grants Program to five recipients: Lower Colorado River Authority, El Paso County Water Improvement District No. 1, Texas A&M AgriLife Research, North Plains Groundwater Conservation District, and Bayview Irrigation District No. 11.
- Water Loss Audits (as of 06/22/20)
 - 611 of the 649 required (94 percent) have been submitted.
 - An additional 593 submitted that are not required.
 - Those requiring follow-up were contacted either by phone or email.
 - 1204 water loss audits have been reviewed year-to-date.
- Water Conservation Annual Reports (as of 06/22/20)
 - 523 of the 833 required (63 percent) have been submitted.
 - Those requiring follow-up were contacted either by phone or email.
- Water Loss Audit Validation Study – Municipal water conservation staff have reviewed the Request for Qualifications submissions and the agency will move towards contracting with one of the firms.

Work Group Updates:

- The Commercial & Institutional work group met in conjunction with the Municipal work group to discuss CI metrics as it relates to the 2020 Legislative Report.
